## XIth INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF ANTHROPOLOGICAL AND ETHNOLOGICAL SCIENCES

The Congress will be in August 1983 in Canada. Before 16th August different pre-congress symposia will be organized in British Columbia and Quebec. The main Congress will be in Vancouver.

The theme of the Congress is "Anthropology and the Public. The Communication of Scholarly Ideas and the Human Context of Data". The president of the Congress and of the International Union of the Anthropological and Ethnological Sciences is Prof. Cyril S. Belshaw. ## SECOND INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF AUXOLOGY AT HAVANA, CUBA

At the close of the International Child's Year there was held at Havana, Cuba, the Second International Congress of Auxology. The sessions took place at the new Congress Hall.

The Congress was attended by some 400 Cubans and almost 300 participants from 27 other countries, most of them from South American states, Mexico, Barbados and the Dominican Republic. There was rather few people from USA, West Germany and Italy, but most other European countries were well represented.

Antecedent to the Congress proper was a two-day course on human growth and development for specialists and undergraduate personnel working in the fields of pediatrics, nutrition, anthropology, psychology and statistics, from Cuba and the South American republics. The lecturers were experts from abroad, the lectures and symposia were devoted to the following subjects: normal growth and development, growth genetics, craniofacial growth, the neuro-hormonal bases of growth, nutrition and growth, anthropology, skeletal maturation, function capacity and applications of biometry to growth and development.

In the course of the Congress there were four plenary sessions, 12 conferences at which representatives of individual countries reported on the progress made in their respective countries in the field concerned, 12 symposia on present subjects, with a total of 78 papers being read and 29 poster talks given.

Auxology as the science of growth is an interdisciplinary branch of science shared by not only pediatrics and anthropology but also psychology, demography, statistics, dietetics and other sciences. The sponsoring institution of the Congress, the International Society of Auxology was founded in 1976 at Rennesand, the First International Congress of Auxology had been held in Rome in 1977.
