The 2 – nd International Competition of Young Artists “Planet and People: Yesterday, Today, Tomorrow”

The International Competition of Young Artists “Planet and People: Yesterday, Today, Tomorrow”, established in 2004, is a festival of children and youth arts and it takes place once in two years.

1. Aim of Project:

- acquainting with life and culture of different nationalities and assistance in keeping friendship and mutual understanding of people from all the parts of the world;
- developing of children’s and teenagers’ imaginations; cultivation of modern generation’s responsibility for the present and future life of our planet.

2. Initiator of competition:

6. Applicants:

- age of applicants: 4 – 24 by September 1st, 2007
- nominations of competition according to the age categories: 4 – 6 years old, 7- 10 years old, 11 – 14 years old, 15 – 18 years old, 19 – 24 years old.

7. Competitive works:

- Subject of artistic work: applicants can choose any topic they like. Paintings, drawings and various artistic works can depict *historic and cultural heritage of your native place or region, peculiar features of your holidays and everyday life, modern life of your country, your vision of the new century, your private dreams. That can be ideas and conceptions,*

animated by imagination, unreal events based on our experience, and perception of everything beautiful surround us.

- Material and technique: painting, graphic arts, arts and crafts. Applicants can use water – colour, gouache, oil – colours, coloured pencils, pastel, various materials for painting, graving, collage or any other graphic means by their own mind. The works can be done on paper, pasteboard or other material. Delicate sculpture works and collages with usage of lightly – spoiled materials cannot be allowed.
- Size of drawing: not exceeding 70 cm. on the biggest side.
- Number of works: every applicant can present not more than 3 works, group – not more than 30 authors' works. The works should be made by the author himself in 2006 – 2007. The works made by group or joint works wouldn't be taken.
- Comments: design of works without frames and certificate with label at the back side of the work (model is enclosed). Information on the label should be written printed in Belarussian, Russian or English. Artistic works are send by post in flat hard packet or box. Collections of authors' works sent by studios, artistic schools and creative groups should include a corresponding list.

8. Term for sending artistic works:

Artistic works would be taken from February 15th to December 15th (the last term for sending) 2007. All the works that are sent later will take part in the 3-d competition.

9. Summing up results of competition:

- consideration of the works and awarding: at the beginning of March 2008
- winners will be informed of the results by the end of April 2008. All the awards will be presented personally or will be sent by post.
- The Catalogue with the names of the winners will be published in 2008.

- Comments: all the works that are sent for the competition are not given back to authors. It is a property of “Apollo” – Studio after the competition. All the artistic works will be used in different scientific and methodological purposes and in programmes conducted with the aim of mutual understanding and international connections. The best works chosen by jury will be a part of a collection that is made by the project of Lyakhovichy State Art Gallery “Apollo” Studio. The initiators of the competition reserve the right for using these works in the capacity of printed produce.

10. Exhibitions:

The artistic works will be shown in May 2008 in Lyakhovichy. After that the mobile exhibition will be shown in Brest region and in many cities and towns of Belarus. The thematic exhibitions will be made.

11. Awards:

- Grand – prize – 3 authors (one of them is Belarussian, two of them are foreign)
- 1st Grade Diploma – 80
- 2nd Grade Diploma – 120
- 3d Grade Diploma – 140
- Special prizes of *organizational committee and Certificate* – Diplomas – 150
- All the artists that have exhibited the works will receive certain certificates.
- The best competitive artistic works are about 450.
- All the teachers will receive special diplomas for training the winners and laureates.

12. Jury of the competition:

- People’s Artists and Honoured Artists of Belarus, Teachers of Belarussian Academy of Arts and Children’s Art Schools, famous people of Belarussian art and culture, members of artistic unions, art historians, psychologists and teachers.
